He loved sports and especially basketball. The Lakers held a special place in his heart and Kobe Bryant was his absolute favorite player. The Denver Broncos was his football team. He also enjoyed Japanese Animation (anime) and that's where he got the name for his first and only fur-daughter, Yachiru (Yachi). He enjoyed Marvel and Star Wars and movies of all kinds. When it came to music, Kenny would listen to anything; his music tastes could be likened to someone as having an 'old soul'. He would give any genre a try at least once.
